Each spring, Arts NC State hosts the Student Art Sale, open to all currently enrolled NC State students. This year's sale takes place on Friday, April 18, 2025 with an application deadline of April 4. You keep 100% of the sales and are eligible for visual artist awards in addition to your sales.
